Economic Development Update – Ray White

- A successful Cybersecurity Business Roundtable, co-sponsored by ODU, at the Economic Development office on 28 March. Over 50 people attended to hear the latest developments in local, regional and statewide cybersecurity activities.
- Point One USA is a Va. Beach military and law enforcement training operation. This service-disabled veteran-owned small business is moving to a 11,000-square-foot existing facility at Crusader Circle. The new property will be used for manufacturing, warehousing and packaging to support product sales of training aids/kits that are purchased and used to support personnel in Virginia, the U.S. and international partners. They are planning a capital investment of \$1.5 million in real estate, business property and for job creation - adding 15 new full-time jobs with an average salary of \$65,000 in the next three years.
- Navy League's Global Maritime Expo Sea Air Space will be held 6-8 May at National Harbor, MD. Economic Development will be attending this event, which is the largest maritime exposition in the U.S.
