

Captain Michael L. Witherspoon Commander Joint Expeditionary Base Little Creek-Fort Story

CAPT Michael Witherspoon is a native of Tuscaloosa, AL. He enlisted in the U.S. Navy as a Machinist Mate Fireman Recruit in October 1986 and was commissioned in 1995 through Officer Candidate School, Pensacola FL as part of the first Seaman to Admiral Program. He

earned his Bachelors of Science degree in Systems Engineering from Norfolk State University (NSU). He also holds a Master's Degree in National Security and Strategy from the U.S. Naval War College in Newport, RI.

His enlisted assignments include the USS McKEE (AS 41) and Navy Recruiting District (NRD) St. Louis. His officer and at sea assignments include Electronic Warfare Officer aboard USS KIDD (DDG 993), Auxiliaries and Electrical Officer (A&E) in USS MERRIMACK (AOE 179), Main Propulsion Assistant (MPA) in USS VELLA GULF (CG 72), Chief Engineer in USS GUNSTON HALL (LSD 44), Commander, Amphibious Squadron TWO (CPR2) serving as Operations Officer (N3), Materials Officer (N4) and Chief Engineer in USS OAK HILL (LSD 51). He served as Executive Officer in Pre-commissioning Detachment and ultimately commissioned the USS GRAVELY (DDG 107). Executive Officer tours in and merger of Maritime Expeditionary Security Squadron FOUR (MSRON 4), Coastal Riverine Squadron FOUR (CRS 4) Maritime Expeditionary Security Squadron TWO (MSRON 2), Coastal Riverine Squadron TWO (CRS 2) and ultimately Commanding Officer of Coastal Riverine Squadron TWO (CRS 2). He deployed in support of numerous wartime and contingency operations to include; OPERATION DESERT SHIELD and DESERT STORM, OPERATION NOBIL ANVIL, OPERATION ENDURING and IRAQI FREEDOM,

Ashore assignments include Operational Test Director (OTD) at Commander, Operational Test and Evaluations Force, Officer-in-Charge (OIC) Coastal Riverine Group TWO Training and Evaluation Unit (CRG2 TEU), and Future Plans (N51) Future Plans in Military Sealift Command, Norfolk VA.

CAPT Witherspoon assumed duties in June 2020 as the Base Commander for Joint Expeditionary Base Little Creek-Fort Story.

His personal awards include the Navy Meritorious Service Medal; Navy Commendation Medal; Army Commendation Medal; Navy Achievement Medal and various unit and service awards.

<u>EQUI-VETS Horsemanship Program:</u> EQUI-VETS will host the Horsemanship Program for 8 wounded warrior participants in conjunction with Tidewater Trails Farm. Participants will learn and work with horses in a hands-on 2-hour session that will share information about horses and therapeutic riding. Participants will focus on working with the horses on the ground to gain confidence in working with horses and ponies, learn about equine therapy, and enjoy a trail ride.

<u>Heroes on the Water:</u> Heroes on the Water serves our Nation's wounded veterans by providing healing and rehabilitating kayak fishing outings that are physically and mentally therapeutic through our nationwide community of volunteers and donors. Heroes on the Water will conduct full day kayak fishing tours in the back waters of Owl's Creek for up to 20 wounded, ill, and injured participants.

<u>Kaizen Adaptive Training:</u> Kaizen Athletics provides an all-inclusive facility to individuals with physical or traumatic impairments (visible/invisible) through movement and community. Fitness for EVERYBODY!

<u>Virginia Beach Adaptive Watersports</u>: BAW's mission is to serve individuals with disabilities in our community, and their families, by offering events such as clinics, workshops and training sessions to instruct and develop our disabled athletes. VBAW will offer water ski lessons at Witchduck Lake.
