Dear Ms. Kelley:

Pursuant to the State and Local Government Conflict of Interests Act, I make the following declaration:

- 1. I am executing this written disclosure regarding the City of Virginia Beach Development Authority's discussion and/or vote regarding the request by Atlantis Preservation, L.P. for the issuance of the Authority's revenue bonds in an amount not to exceed \$39,000,000.
- 2. I have a business relationship with the Atlantis Preservation, LP.

Although the City Attorney has advised me that I do not have a "personal interest" in Atlantis Preservation, L.P. as that term is defined by the Act., due to my business relationship, and although I am able to participate in this transaction fairly and in the public interest, as provided by Virginia Code Section 2.2-3115(I), I am nonetheless electing to abstain from this vote.
