**Monthly Highlights** 

Black Business Month is celebrated in August — it's a time to acknowledge and appreciate black-owned businesses across the nation and all that they represent in the country's continual strive for diversity and equality. Black Business Month is exciting because it gives us an opportunity to focus on a community that is far too often underrepresented when it comes to access to capital and opportunities to build wealth.

When we celebrate the contribution of black business owners and entrepreneurs, it pays homage to them and their legacies, especially since celebrating this month recognizes the importance of blackowned businesses when it comes to contributing to the nation's economy as well. Approximately 10% of all American businesses are black-owned, and if we look at what statistics say about minority-owned businesses, about 30% of these would belong to black business owners. The primary sectors in which black-owned businesses operate include health care, social work, repair and maintenance, beauty salons, restaurants, and more. As of 2017, the Census Bureau recorded 9,407 businesses in Virginia Beach. Of those 9,407 businesses 1,168 business are minority owned. Virginia Beach landed on the top spot of cities where African Americans fare best economically and where black businesses thrive...more than five percent of businesses are Black owned in the Virginia Beach-Norfolk-Newport News metro area, the seventh-highest percentage overall for the metric.

This historic annual event provides a chance for consumers and proprietors to not only support Black businesses but provide them a platform to grow their enterprises and build wealth for current and future generations of African Americans. It too has been estimated that Black entrepreneurs can earn over 10 times more than non-Black business owners, helping trim the racial wealth gap and promoting economic balance.

Observers say it's crucial consumers and business owners support Black business owners during the month for several other reasons. For instance, more than ever, patronage is needed as many Black firms are rebounding from the pandemic and have experienced a tougher time doing so than other groups. In fact, some 53% of Black business owners saw revenues fall by 50% or more since COVID-19 became a widespread concern, versus just 37% of white business owners.

Others add that backing is needed due to systemic racism throughout the nation, and Black businesses need assurance they are not fighting those conditions alone. Moreover, such advocacy and consumerism promote diversity and inclusion as Black businesses tend to hire more diverse employees and invest in their communities.

#### Ways to provide support include:

A. Celebrates Black businesses & entrepreneurs

Black Business Month is an opportunity to recognize the hard work and dedication of Black entrepreneurs. It's a way to promote their achievements and successes, as well as celebrate their contributions to our economy.

B. Support economic growth in the Black community

By purchasing from a minority owned business, you are actively supporting economic growth in the Black community. Every dollar spent helps keep more money in your local neighborhood and creates more job opportunities for people in the area.

C. Educates others on the importance of diversity

Taking part in Black Business Month is a great way to show solidarity with members of the Black community and start conversations about why it's important to support minority owned businesses. The celebration also helps spread awareness about why diversity is important for businesses and communities.

### **Owner, Dominique Hawkins**

Dominique Hawkins attended LPN School in Virginia, graduating in 2008. The following summer, she enrolled in an LPN to RN Bridge Program, which she finished in 2011.

Ms. Dawkins ventured into entrepreneurship in 2021, and started two businesses: NP ON DEMAND LLC and K&D SCRUBS LLC. The former is a virtual telemedicine practice concentrating on weight loss services and medical clearances for cosmetic surgery, while also providing IV hydration services to our local patients in their homes or offices. The latter is a commercial cleaning company operating in Virginia Beach, specializing in cleaning apartments, offices, and other commercial entities. Ms. Hawkins also runs a thriving vitamin company called HEMOSTAT-VITAMINS. "As a relentless entrepreneur, the concept of failure does not cross my mind! I feel truly blessed to be living a purposeful life".

A few of Ms. Hawkins accomplishments included her being a recent graduate of the Economic Uplift Capital Accelerator (EUCA) program at The Hive VB Business Resource Center in July 2023. Prior to that, she was appointed to the Health Advisory Board for City, holds a board certification as a Family Nurse Practitioner and is licensed in eight (8) states as a Nurse Practitioner.
