VIRGINIA WESLEYAN UNIVERSITY

Virginia Wesleyan University and Virginia Beach Economic Development have cultivated a successful partnership spanning three years, aimed at nurturing Talent Development Programs. These initiatives operate within The Hive-VB Business Resource Center at Town Center, various local businesses, and the Virginia Beach Talent Development Center situated at VWU.

As Virginia Beach's university, the oldest institution founded and based in the City, we take immense pride in this enduring alliance.

Over the **2022-23** period, we've served a substantial **2,600 learners** focused on workforce enhancement, resulting in the issuance of more than **1,000 certificates**," said Dr. Scott D. Miller, President of the University.

Since its inception in **2020**, this program has brought significant benefits to the Coastal Virginia community. Over 1**3,000 Hampton Roads residents**, including more than **10,000 from Virginia Beach**, have reaped the rewards of these offerings. During the **2022–23** academic year, approximately **1,700 participants** engaged in workshops and programs, leveraging facilities at The Hive, on-campus conveniences, and the premises of Virginia Beach enterprises. Additionally, **900 individuals** accessed the VWU Online platform for flex time Workforce Development offerings. In a concerted effort to benefit the local community, a diverse array of **23 workforce-centric classes** were presented this year at **zero cost** for Virginia Beach residents.

Topics ranged from career exploration to mastering effective communication, personal finance, professional sales skills, cybersecurity certifications and more. Parallelly, numerous other courses were conducted at The Hive and on-site at various commercial establishments.

The HIVE is incredibly grateful for our partnership with the Hampton Roads Workforce Council (HRWC).

Established by the Hampton Roads Workforce Development Board, the Hampton Roads Workforce Council oversees **federally funded workforce development programs** for **ALL** localities in the **Hampton Roads region.** The HRWC provides strategic workforce development solutions designed to assist businesses in accessing qualified workers and job seekers in search of suitable job openings and training opportunities to bolster their earning potential. The HRWC is currently working with over **120 Virginia Beach Businesses**. For each company HRWC is providing either hiring, recruiting, training, and/or retaining services.

Between July 1st, 2022 - June 30th, 2023

HRWC assisted **350 VB businesses** with Workforce Recruitment Services, Rapid Response, Incumbent Worker Training, On-the- Job Training, Employer Information/Supportive Services, and Strategic Planning.
HRWC assisted **2,559 VB residents** with training and career counseling. Enrolled **108 VB residents** into training programs. Enrolled **22 VB residents** into the VB Relief Program

GET FREE COACHING SERVICES, ACCESS TO CAPITAL (LOANS OR FREE GOVERNMENT GRANTS), CERTIFICATION ASSISTANCE AND MORE. THEY HELP PEOPLE CREATE A BUSINESS PLAN, MANAGE CASH, GET FINANCING AND SUPPORT THE MWBE COMMUNITY IN ANY WAY POSSIBLE.

37 ANGELS

37 ANGELS IS AN ORGANIZATION MADE UP OF FEMALE ANGEL INVESTORS THAT INVEST IN WOMEN-OWNED SMALL BUSINESSES. THE ORGANIZATION RECOGNIZES THE DISADVANTAGES THAT FEMALE ENTREPRENEURS FACE IN THE LOAN MARKET AND SEEKS TO CLOSE THAT GAP. TO HELP WOMEN KEEP THEIR COMPANIES AFLOAT, 37 ANGELS OFFERS GRANTS AS LARGE AS \$150,000.

SBA MICROLOANS

THESE GOVERNMENT-BACKED LOANS OF UP TO \$50,000 CAN BE A GOOD CHOICE FOR NEW OR VERY SMALL BUSINESSES. THEY'RE TYPICALLY ISSUED BY NONPROFIT COMMUNITY FINANCIAL INSTITUTIONS, MANY OF WHICH OFFER ADDITIONAL TRAINING AND RESOURCES.

VIRGINIA BEACH SMALL BUSINESS CAPITAL ACCESS PROGRAM -REOPEN

THE CITY OF VIRGINIA BEACH ANNOUNCED THE REOPENING OF THE CAPITAL ACCESS PROGRAM TO PROVIDE FUNDING TO QUALIFYING SMALL BUSINESSES IN THE FORM OF ZERO-INTEREST LOANS. APPLICATIONS ACCEPTED UNTIL FUNDS EXPIRE.

ETSY EMERGENCY RELIEF FUND

IF YOU'RE AN ETSY BUSINESS OWNER, YOU MAY BE QUALIFIED TO APPLY FOR RELIEF FUNDING COURTESY OF A PARTNERSHIP WITH CERF+, A NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION DEDICATED TO HELPING ARTISTS PREPARE FOR AND RECOVER FROM EMERGENCIES AND DISASTERS. TO APPLY, YOU MUST HAVE BEEN A REGISTERED ETSY BUSINESS FOR AT LEAST ONE YEAR AND HAVE BEEN AFFECTED BY A NATURAL DISASTER. THIS GRANT OPPORTUNITY IS ROLLING.

ECONOMIC EQUITY FUND

A \$10 MILLION LOAN FUND THAT PROVIDES LOW-COST FINANCING FOR SMALL, BIPOC- AND/OR WOMEN-OWNED BUSINESSES THAT WERE DISPROPORTIONATELY AFFECTED BY THE ECONOMIC IMPACT OF THE PANDEMIC. AVAILABLE BETWEEN NOW AND DECEMBER 2024.

SAMHSA: THE SUBSTANCE ABUSE AND MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES ADMINISTRATION

WISH LOCAL EMPOWERMENT GRANT

BLACK BUSINESS OWNERS CAN APPLY FOR \$500 - \$2,000 GRANTS THROUGH THE WISH LOCAL EMPOWERMENT GRANT PROGRAM. TO BE ELIGIBLE, YOU MUST BE AT LEAST 18 YEARS OLD, HAVE 20 OR FEWER EMPLOYEES AND MUST OWN A BRICK-AND-MORTAR LOCATION IN THE UNITED STATES.

FRESH START BUSINESS GRANT

Fresh Start Business Grant. If you're a new business owner or an aspiring entrepreneur looking for capital to grow or launch your business, the Fresh Start Business Grant was made for you. Incfile, a company that helps form businesses, wants to support those looking to start new ventures. Recipients of the grant will receive \$2,500 in addition to Incfile's free gold plan. The 2023 deadlines are March 31, June 30, and September 30.

BELLE CAPITAL

Belle Capital is an investment firm focused on companies led by women. Their mission is to help mitigate the unfair gap in funding that women receive compared to men. Although women continue to prove themselves as successful entrepreneurs; their businesses even proving to do better than that of their male counterparts' in some cases, they still receive less funding than men. SBIR Small Business Innovation Research **STTR** Small Business Technology Transfer

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The Small Business Innovation Research (SBIR) program strengthens opportunities for innovative small businesses using federally funded research. The program stimulates technological innovation, uses small businesses to meet federal research needs, and enables participation by socially and economically disadvantaged businesses. Additionally, the program facilitates the transition of the resulting research into the commercial sector, a strategy that increases competition, productivity and economic growth.

The Small Business Technology Transfer (STTR) program is a sister program to SBIR that requires the small business to partner with a University, a Federally Funded Research and Development Center, or a qualified non-profit research institution. The STTR standards require the small business to serve a the prime contractor and perform at least 40 percent of the work, with the research partner performing at least 30 percent of the work. The remaining work may be done either the small business, the research partner, or by a third party.
