

Virginia Beach Development Authority Awards Over \$144,000 in Small Business Grants


From cutting-edge eye care technology to innovative youth automotive training, 17 local businesses are set to revolutionize their operations thanks to a total of \$144,811 in Small Business Grants from the Virginia Beach Development Authority (VBDA). These strategic investments will catalyze small business growth across the city, providing essential funding for expansion, innovation, and economic development.

The VBDA launched the Small Business Grant Program in September 2024 to support small-, women-, minority-, veteran-, and disabled veteran-owned businesses in Virginia Beach. Offering grants of up to \$10,000, the program aims to empower local entrepreneurs by providing the financial resources needed to enhance services, create jobs, and drive long-term success within the community.

A total of 17 businesses from various districts have been awarded grants, enabling growth across multiple sectors, including technology, entertainment, automotive, business consulting, and publishing. Businesses utilizing grants for digital transformation and innovation include <u>Snapqube Corp</u>, <u>Security Scholars LLC</u>, <u>Open Door Media Solutions</u>, <u>Executive Decisions</u> and <u>Vault Athletics & Fitness</u>. Others, like <u>Unique Skin and Beauty Bar</u> and <u>F.L.Y. Enterprises Inc.</u>, are investing in education and training initiatives. Physical expansion projects are being undertaken by <u>First Class Beauty Suites</u> and <u>Bounce Hoppers</u>, while <u>Food Temptress Cookbook Store LLC</u>, <u>Greight Company Limited</u> and <u>The Book Artist LLC</u> are leading marketing innovations. Other companies like EauBleue Solutions 757 Transport, <u>Elizabeth M Borza O.D. Inc.</u>, <u>Brush It On Paint Co</u>, <u>Type A Virtual Solutions</u> and <u>Freedom Title & Escrow</u> will add new equipment.

"Virginia Beach's entrepreneurial spirit is getting a significant boost," said Virginia Beach Deputy City Manager Amanda Jarratt. "These investments represent more than just business growth – they're about creating new opportunities, enhancing services, and strengthening our local economy. When our small businesses thrive, Virginia Beach thrives." These grants will help recipients implement strategic growth initiatives, ensuring a lasting impact on the city's business landscape and economic vitality.

SMALL BUSINESS GRANTS & LOANS

Virginia Minority Business Development Agency

Funded by the U.S. Department of Commerce, Minority Business Development Agency, they help Minority Business Entrepreneurs gain greater access to contracts/markets/capital in the Federal/State/Local/Commercial space. They deliver strategic business consulting, technical assistance & work to understand your capabilities to develop near & long-term strategic growth.

<u> 37 Angels</u>

37 angels is an organization made up of female angel investors that invest in womenowned small businesses. The organization recognizes the disadvantages that female entrepreneurs face in the loan market and seeks to close that gap. To help women keep their companies afloat, 37 Angels offers grants as large as \$150,000.

Amazon Black Business Accelerator

Grow your business with dedicated resources, financial assistance, business education & coaching, and marketing & advertising support.

SBA Microloans

These government-backed loans of up to \$50,000 can be a good choice for new or very small businesses. They're typically issued by nonprofit community financial institutions, many of which offer additional training and resources.

The Freed Fellowship Grant

Each month, a small-business owner can receive a \$500 micro-grant from the Freed Fellowship. Monthly grant recipients are also eligible for a \$2,500 annual grant. Applications are accepted on a rolling basis. While this grant is open to all small-business owners, women and minority entrepreneurs are encouraged to apply.

SMALL BUSINESS GRANTS & LOANS

<u>National Association for the Self-</u> <u>Employed Growth Grants</u>

This nonprofit trade association provides educational resources and grants for small businesses and entrepreneurs. To apply for a grant of yo to \$4,000, you'll need to become an active member of the association, provide a detailed explanation of how you'll use the funds, show how the grant will support your business growth and provide supporting documentation.

<u>Small Business</u> <u>Innovation Research</u> <u>Program</u>

The Small Business Innovation Research (SBIR) program strengthens opportunities for innovative small businesses using federally funded research. The program stimulates technological innovation, uses small businesses to meet federal research needs, and enables participation by socially and economically disadvantaged businesses.

Hello Alice Grants

Hello Alice provides a single application for multiple grants, as well as knowledge, networking, and connections for entrepreneurs. New grants are constantly being added.

<u>Virginia SBDC</u> <u>Funding Resources</u>

The SBDC offers information and resources on federal, state and local loan programs, tax incentives, and other financial resources available to both established small businesses and startups.

Galaxy Grant

This grant program, which is presented by Hidden Star, a nonprofit organization, is open to women and minority small-business owners. Winners can currently receive a \$1,500 grant.

SMALL BUSINESS GRANTS & LOANS

Community Business Partnership (CBP)

The CBP serves startups and existing small business owners including women, veterans, and minorities primarily located in the DMV Metropolitan region. The business owners we serve are across most business sectors and have a wide range of financial positions. However, we focus on supporting micro-enterprises that are underbanked and underserved in our community.

<u>Virginia Economic Development Incentive Grant</u> (VEDIG)

The Virginia Economic Development Incentive Grant program (VEDIG) assists and encourages companies to invest and create new employment opportunities by locating significant headquarters, administrative, or service sector operations in Virginia. There must be an active and realistic competition between Virginia and another state or country for attracting the project.

<u>Grants.gov</u>

Grants.gov is one of the first resources you may want to investigate for business grants —both minority grants and other opportunities. The database, maintained by the Office of Management and Budget (OMB), contains information about more than 1,000 federal grants. It also includes details about the eligibility requirements for each program

To apply for a grant through the Grants.gov system, you'll need to first establish a Workspace account that you (and your team) use to access the system's applications. Once you complete this step, you'll be free to search for federal grants that align with your business goals and apply for those you believe are a good match for you.

For Women Only SMALL BUSINESS GRANTS & LOANS

The Amber Grant

This grant is for women only, and there is an award every month. This grant was founded after the untimely death of a young women named Amber. She passed before she could realize her dreams of starting a business.

Backstage Capital

Backstage invests in startup founders who identify as a Woman, Person of Color, and/or LGBTQ. They believe these founders are underestimated and have the most potential for unlocking innovation and creating valuable businesses. To support more founders, they're growing a global community of local accelerator programs.

Grantsforwomen.org

Grants For Women helps small business owners find and research grant opportunities. The grants differ in scope, region, qualifying criteria, and amount, based on the institution offering them.

IFundWomen Universal Grant

At IFundWomen, members have access to a variety of grants, from our monthly Pay-It-Forward crowdfunding grant to those from corporate partners like Visa, Unilever, Diageo, Vista, adidas, American Express, and more.

Her Village Grants

Her Village grants awarded to qualifying nonprofit organizations support work that advances and strengthens entrepreneurial skills, resources, ecosystems, access to capital, and educational opportunities for female founders. In 2025, the Her Village Grant Program will evolve to meet our goal of making deep impact alongside likeminded organizations.
