It was one of the first cities in the United States to pass an anti-discrimination ordinance that included sexual orientation. The city is also home to a vibrant LGBTQ community. There are several gay-friendly businesses and organizations in Virginia Beach, including Virginia Wesleyan University being named a 2022 Best College for LGBTQ+ students and #1 College in Virginia for LGBTQ+ by BestColleges.com. Virginia Beach is a great place to visit for anyone, regardless of their sexual orientation. The city offers a wide range of activities and attractions that appeal to all types of travelers.

Many people consider it to be a resort city...but for more than 30 years, the LGBTQ Life Center has been a vital part of the Virginia Beach community by providing support, education, and celebrations for the LGBTQ community. Virginia Beach is home to other support organizations such as the Virginia Beach Human Rights Commission, an advisory agency to the City Council that assures and the Hampton Roads LGBT Chamber of Commerce (HRBOR) that serves as a community resource for organizations and government entities and maintains a strong presence in local higher education. Members actively mentor upcoming business leaders from the area's colleges and universities. HRBOR promotes LGBT influence through business ownership, workforce equality and active consumerism, creating prosperity to support equality, diversity and inclusion.
