


EDIP Grant Approved for Columbus Town Center II Redevelopment

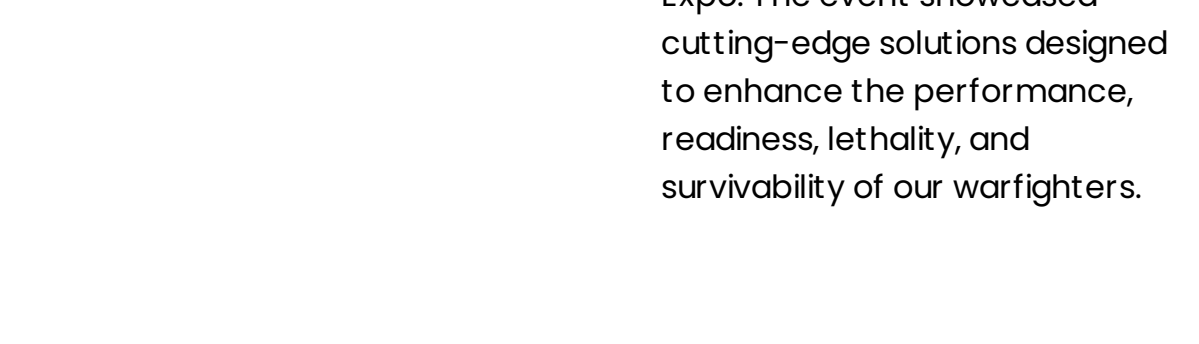
17th Street Set for Major Revitalization
